### Applications sought for PERSI Retirement Board opening

Governor Brad Little is now accepting applications to fill an existing spot on the Public Employee Retirement System of Idaho Board (PERSI) for a term that will expire on July 1, 2021.

The PERSI Retirement Board is responsible for overseeing PERSI's general administrative duties including their annual budget and the fund's investment activities, setting contribution rates, awarding Cost-of-Living Adjustments, and approving proposed legislation that directly affects the organization and its beneficiaries.

Qualified applicants must not be a current member of PERSI except by reason of serving on the board as required by Idaho Code [59-1304](#). The position also requires Senate confirmation.
